

# Thousand Islands Performing Arts

Dear Alumnus:

As you may or may not be aware – the Thousand Islands Schools and the Thousand Islands Music Department have established a Thousand Islands Performing Arts Hall of Fame. Beginning this year, we will be honoring graduates (along with some honorary members) at our annual Spring Concert.

The purpose of the Hall of Fame is as follows:

- To honor alumni of the school who made a significant contribution to the school and the music department while they were students.
- To help make current students aware of the accomplishments of alumni.
- To help current students become familiar with how past students continue to enjoy the performing arts in their adult lives.
- To encourage current students to make their own significant contributions to the school and the music department

Selection into the Hall of Fame is based on the following criteria:

- The nominee will be an alumnus of Thousand Islands who graduated at least five years prior to his or her nomination.
- The nominee should have made a significant contribution to the music program or other performing arts programs at Thousand Islands.
- Music or other performing arts should remain an important part of the nominee's adult life.

We are asking for your help by seeking your input for nominations. If you know of someone who meets the three criteria listed above, please fill out the enclosed nomination form and return it to me at school. (The address is on the nomination form.) Nominations must be received by January 1<sup>st</sup> in order to be considered for the 2017 award. A committee will review the nominations and select the honorees. Once nominations have been submitted, they remain active. Individuals who are nominated, but not selected in a given year will be considered in future years. You do not have to re-nominate a person every year.
